Let's talk: Work-life balance

Tom: Yes, people are working long hours. Do you know that 30% of UK workers take work home in the evening and at weekends?

Eric: Really? Hmm... in the evenings and at weekends, that's a lot of work.

Tom: Yes, it's a real problem... for our quality of life, I mean.

Marie: Right! And there are also problems at work for mothers with young children and workers who look after ill or old family members.

Eric: Of course. Are there any solutions to these issues?

Tom: Well, companies are looking for solutions. They're studying new ways of working.

Eric: What are these new ways of working?

Marie: For example companies can introduce flexible working hours. I mean, workers start work early and finish work early, or start work late and finish work late.

Tom: Or they can encourage homeworking. Workers can use the Internet and work from home, that way they save time as they don't travel to the office.

Marie: Yes, this is another way of solving the problem of too much work. Workers can work two or three days a week.

Let's talk: Speed dating

Marie: Good evening.

Tom: Hello.

Eric: Tom and Marie, tonight I'd like to hear your thoughts on... on these new ways for people to meet their ideal partner.

Tom: What do you mean Eric?

Eric: Well, a friend of mine's going to a speed dating event next week and he wants me to go with him. I don't know what to do... I'm curious... I'd like to try but...

Marie: Come on Eric. No "but's"! You have to go! Speed dating's great fun! And even if you don't find your soul mate, it's an interesting way to spend an evening.

Tom: That's true! Speed dating's really popular at the moment. It's a great opportunity to meet people. Sometimes, very interesting people!

Marie: Yes! And sometimes you can fall in love! I know a guy who married a girl he met speed dating!

Eric: Hmm... this speed dating sounds interesting! I'm single, you know, but how does it work? Perhaps you can explain this to our viewers too! I'm sure people would like to know exactly how speed dating works... I'd certainly like to find out!

Tom: Well, speed dating events usually take place in nightclubs or pubs. The participants have a number and they sit around tables. The men are on one side, the women are on the other side.

Marie: Then the fun starts! You have four minutes to ask your questions, only four minutes remember. The other person asks questions too. Then you move to the next table and ask your questions again.

Eric: What kind of questions can I ask?

Tom: Anything you like. For example "What's your name?", "How old are you?", "What are your interests?". The kind of questions that you ask when you meet someone for the first time.

Eric: And what happens next?

Marie: Well, you write down your thoughts about the person. The person facing you does the same thing. At the end of the event you give your thoughts about the people to the organisers.

Eric: What do you mean... "my thoughts"?

Marie: It's easy, you select the people you'd like to meet again; the organisers then add your decisions to their website.

Eric: And then what happens?
