Music: John Lennon

Tony: He started a successful solo career. "Imagine" and "Plastic Ono Band" were popular albums.

Lucy: Did John ever try to re-unite the Beatles?

Tony: Oh No! His relationship with Yoko Ono became very, very important for him. John and Yoko started to get involved in politics, they began to spread a message of world peace.

Lucy: And when was he killed?

Tony: John was killed on 8th December 1980 outside his New York apartment in the Dakota Building.

Lucy: Who killed him?

Tony: Mark David Chapman, a Beatles fan.

Lucy: And why?

Tony: Well he was crazy, he was mad, he said Lennon had

betrayed the ideals of his generation!


